On June 16, 2023, pursuant to Section 4-210 of the Public Utilities Article, *Annotated Code of Maryland*, Washington Gas Light Company (“Washington Gas”) filed an application with the Commission for approval of a new gas system strategic infrastructure development and enhancement plan (“the STRIDE 3 Plan”) and an accompanying cost recovery mechanism¹ (collectively, “Application”). The Company also submitted documentation supporting its proposed Application, proposed tariff revisions, and accompanying written testimony. In its Application, the Company asks the Commission to approve a new STRIDE plan for plan years 2024-2028, effective January 1, 2024.

IT IS THEREFORE, this 6th day of July in the year Two Thousand Twenty-Three, by the Public Service Commission of Maryland, **ORDERED**:

(1) that proceedings to consider the Application and the justness and reasonableness of the Washington Gas Light Company’s Application are instituted by the Commission; and
