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REQUEST FOR COMMENTS

On May 14, 2021, Staff Counsel of the Commission filed the Small Generator Facility Interconnection Phase III Report of the PC44 Interconnection Workgroup,¹ on behalf of the Staff of the Public Service Commission. The Workgroup report discusses interconnection jurisdiction, interconnection facility costs, Maryland smart inverter setting standards, utility monitoring and control plans, and circuit hosting capacity for small generator facilities, and also includes proposed revisions to the Commission's interconnection regulations.
