NOTICE OF HEARING ON ENERGY STORAGE PROPOSAL

On January 14, 2019, the Public Conference 44 (“PC44”) Energy Storage Working Group filed with the Maryland Public Service Commission (“Commission”) a Proof of Regulatory Concept Program Proposal (“Proposal”) with comments on the Proposal submitted by Baltimore Gas and Electric Company, Potomac Electric Power Company and Delmarva Power and Light Company (joint comments), and the Maryland Energy Administration appended to the Proposal.¹ The Proposal requests the Commission approve the program design and general framework.

The Commission finds that having a legislative-style hearing to consider the comments and the Proposal is the most efficient and effective method to determine the most appropriate action on the Proposal. Interested parties may file written comments on the Proposal by March 1, 2019, with reply comments due by March 8, 2019. A legislative-style hearing will be held on Wednesday, March 13, 2019, beginning at 1:00 p.m. in Commission’s Frank O. Heintz
