REQUEST FOR COMMENTS

On January 5, 2022, the Community Choice Working Group Leader filed a recommendation to the Commission that transition of residential and small commercial customers from their current service to the Community Choice Aggregator occur no earlier than October 1, 2024, and "that the Commission docket for consideration in Case No. 9056/9064, any
