Maryland PSC to Hold Another Public Comment Hearing for Fairview Farm Solar Project in Harford County

(BALTIMORE, MD-April 7, 2020) – The Maryland Public Service Commission will hold a second virtual public comment hearing on the request by PTR HoldCo, LLC to build the 30 MW Fairview Farm solar facility in Harford County, Maryland. The hearing, to be conducted by Public Utility Law Judge Christine Burke, will be held **Tuesday, April 20, 2021 at 7 p.m.** The first public comment hearing on the project was held December 15, 2020.

PTR HoldCo proposes to construct the project on approximately 140 acres of property owned by Fairview Farms, LLC, located at 2000 Calvary Road in Bel Air. The project will include approximately 102,000 photovoltaic panels, 13 power centers, and two interconnection points along Calvary Road.
