Maryland PSC to Hold Public Hearing for Solar Project in Prince George's County

(BALTIMORE, MD-August 29, 2019) – The Maryland Public Service Commission will hold a public comment hearing on a request by Spectrum Solar, LLC to build a 5.6 MW solar generating facility in Prince George's County. The hearing will be held **Tuesday, September 10, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. at the Oxon Hill Volunteer Fire Department, 7600 Livingston Road in Oxon Hill.** Members of the public who wish to comment on the proposal are welcome to attend the hearing before Public Utility Law Judge Jennifer Grace.

The facility is proposed to be constructed on 30 acres located at 4700 Full Gospel Boulevard in Oxon Hill.
