Dear Mr. Pincelli:

On February 13, 2023, the Commission issued a Notice of Probable Cause Hearing¹ directing SunSea Energy, LLC ("SunSea") to file by March 1, 2023, a response to allegations of violations of Maryland law. The Commission also directed SunSea to appear at the Commission's March 8, 2023, Administrative Hearing to determine whether there was probable cause to refer the matter for evidentiary proceedings.

On February 21, 2023, SunSea Energy submitted a request for an extension of time to respond to the Commission's Notice of Probable Cause Hearing. The Company indicates in its filing that additional time was needed for counsel and SunSea to confer and evaluate each allegation in order to provide a comprehensive response.

After considering this matter, the Commission hereby grants a one-week extension (to March 8, 2023) for SunSea to file a response to the Commission, and SunSea is now directed to appear at the March 15, 2023 Administrative Meeting.
