- Participate and support the Maryland Diverse Supplier Workgroup
- Set goals, meet with vendors and internal business leaders to seek out areas of opportunity
- Participate in national and regional organizations such as:

 - oU.S. Small Business Administration (SBA)
 - o Women's Business Enterprise National Council
 - o Women President's Education Organization
- Continually monitor and review our supplier diversity program for possible changes and enhancements

Plans for recruiting Diverse Suppliers of products and services where utilization has been low, underutilized or currently unavailable (MOU § 3.2.1).

- Conduct sessions with internal business leaders and supply chain staff to ensure understanding of the goals and departmental responsibilities and to identify and expand areas of opportunity for diverse suppliers.
- Continue to develop plans and strategies to use diverse suppliers in all aspects of our business.

Plans for encouraging Prime Contractors to engage Diverse Suppliers in subcontracts that include subcontracting opportunities (MOU \S 3.3).

 Work with prime contractor to develop a subcontracting plan to include minority vendors

Plans for complying with the established Diverse Supplier program guidelines (MOU § 6.1)

- Continue to monitor our reporting and tracking system to provide spend information from diverse suppliers.
- Meet with other Maryland utilities and industry contacts in an effort to increase supplier diversity awareness and further enhance the Supplier Diversity initiative.
- Submit the Annual Reports as outlined in Section 6 of the MOU.
