Public Comment Hearing Set for Columbia Gas Rate Increase Request

(BALTIMORE, MD) – The Maryland Public Service Commission will hold a virtual public comment hearing on the request by Columbia Gas of Maryland to increase its rates by more than \$6.7 million. The utility’s customers and other interested parties are welcome to take part in the hearing scheduled for **Tuesday, August 23, 2022** at 7:00 p.m. Public Utility Law Judge Jennifer Grace will preside over the hearing which will begin with a presentation by Columbia Gas.

Columbia Gas, a subsidiary of NiSource, Inc., provides retail natural gas distribution service to approximately 34,000 customers in the Maryland counties of Allegany, Garrett and Washington. As proposed, the total bill for an average residential customer would increase by \$10.66 per month, or 11.34%. The company’s most recent prior rate case was decided by the Commission in December 2021.
