Maryland PSC Sets Second Public Hearing for Cherrywood Solar Project in Caroline County

(BALTIMORE, MD-November 1, 2018) – The Maryland Public Service Commission will hold a second public comment hearing on the application of Cherrywood Solar I, LLC to construct a 202 MW solar generating facility in Caroline County, Maryland. The hearing will be held on **Thursday, November 15, 2018, at 7:00 p.m. at the Greensboro Fire Hall, 13781 Greensboro Road in Greensboro, Maryland.** Members of the public who wish to comment on the matter are welcome to attend the hearing before Public Utility Law Judge Jennifer J. Grace. The first public comment hearing in this case was held on May 2, 2018.

According to the application, the solar facility will be constructed on 16 parcels in the vicinity of the towns of Greensboro and Goldsboro in Caroline County.
