Maryland PSC to Hold Third Public Hearing for Richfield Solar Project in Dorchester County

(BALTIMORE, MD-October 22, 2018) – The Maryland Public Service Commission will hold a third public comment hearing on the application by Richfield Solar Energy, LLC to construct a 50 MW solar project in Dorchester County, Maryland. The hearing will be held on **Monday, November 5, 2018 at 6:30pm** at the **Hurlock Town Hall, 311 Charles Street in Hurlock**. Members of the public who wish to comment on the project may attend the hearing before Chief Public Utility Law Judge Ryan C. McLean. This hearing follows two others held January 9, 2018 and September 12, 2018.

On June 29, 2018, Richfield Solar amended its application to modify the parcels of land on which the project would be built, and also to relocate a related substation. The application and environmental review documents are available for public inspection or copying at the Dorchester County Planning and Zoning Office, Dorchester County Office Building (Room 107), 501 Court Lane, Cambridge, Maryland 21613.
