## Maryland PSC Schedules Second Public Hearing for Richfield Solar Project in Dorchester County

(BALTIMORE, MD-August 29, 2018) – The Maryland Public Service Commission will hold a second public comment hearing on the application of Richfield Solar Energy, LLC to construct a 50 MW solar generating facility in Dorchester County, Maryland. The hearing will be held on **Wednesday, September 12, 2018, at 6:30 p.m. at the Hurlock Town Hall, 311 Charles Street in Hurlock, Maryland.** Members of the public who wish to comment on the matter are welcome to attend the hearing before Chief Public Utility Law Judge Ryan C. McLean. The first public hearing was held on January 9 of this year.

Richfield Solar has amended its application to modify the parcels of land on which the project would be built, and also to relocate a related substation. The application and environmental review documents are available for public inspection or copying at the Dorchester County Planning and Zoning Office, Dorchester County Office Building (Room 107), 501 Court Lane in Cambridge, Maryland.
