## **Maryland PSC to Hold Two Public Hearings for Potomac Edison Transmission Line Rebuild**

(BALTIMORE, MD-October 18, 2018) – The Maryland Public Service Commission will hold two public comment hearings on the application by the Potomac Edison Company for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to modify the Ringgold-Catoctin transmission line from the existing single-circuit 138 kV transmission line to a 230 kV transmission line that traverses a nearly 10-mile stretch between the Ringgold substation in Washington County and the Catoctin substation in Frederick County.

Members of the public who wish to comment on the project may attend one or both of the hearings before Chief Public Utility Law Judge Ryan C. McLean, scheduled as follows:
