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NOTICE OF MODIFICATION TO RULE MAKING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On March 3, 2015 the Maryland Public Service Commission (“Commission”) issued a Notice of Rule Making Session scheduled for May 7 and 8, 2015 with proposed revisions to COMAR 20.50.12.02 to be filed by the Commission’s Technical Staff (“Staff”) by April 23, 2015. The Commission hereby provides notice that the rule making session has been changed to Thursday, June 4, 2015 and Friday, June 5, 2015 (if needed), beginning at 10:00 a.m. in the Commission’s 16<sup>th</sup> Floor Hearing Room, William Donald Schaefer Tower, 6 St. Paul Street, Baltimore, Maryland 21202. In addition, the Commission’s Technical Staff (“Staff”) is hereby directed to file by Tuesday, May 19, 2015 its analysis and recommendations regarding the Utilities’ proposed reliability standards<sup>1</sup>, including proposed modifications to the regulations

incorporating such annual standards for the 2016-2019 timeframe.

The purpose of the rule making session is to consider whether to publish the proposed revisions to COMAR 20.50.12.02 to be filed by Staff, on or before May 19, 2015, or as modified by the Commission at the rule making session. If the Commission adopts the proposed regulations for publication, the proposed rules will be published in the Maryland Register for notice and comment as provided for by the Maryland Administrative Procedures Act.
