**NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT**

**To: Service List for RM43 and Interested Persons**

On October 13, 2015, in response to the Maryland Public Service Commission’s (“Commission”) request at its September 1-2 Rule Making Session, the Potomac Electric Power Company (“Pepco” or “Company”) filed a status report on vegetation management activities along Pepco’s transmission corridor, the actions Pepco is taking or has taken in response to issues raised by customers along the transmission corridor, and the Company’s customer communications related to vegetation management (“Status Report”). The Commission hereby provides notice of an opportunity to comment on the Status Report filed by Pepco. The purpose of receiving comments on this Report is to further assist the Vegetation Management Work Group chaired by the Commission’s Technical Staff and initiated by the Commission at the September 1-2 Rule Making Session, with discussion points that the utilities and stakeholders can utilize while evaluating vegetation management practices under this Docket.
