**NOTICE OF MODIFICATION TO RULE MAKING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

**To: Service List for RM43 and Interested Persons**

Due to scheduling conflicts, the Maryland Public Service Commission (“Commission”) hereby provides a second further notice that the rule making session currently scheduled for July 9 and 10, 2015 has been changed to Thursday, July 23, 2015 and Friday, July 24, 2015 (if needed), beginning at 10:00 a.m. in the Commission’s 16<sup>th</sup> Floor Hearing Room, William Donald Schaefer Tower, 6 St. Paul Street, Baltimore, Maryland 21202. In addition, deadline dates for filing comments has also been modified. Accordingly, the Commission’s Technical Staff (“Staff”) is hereby directed to file by Friday, June 26, 2015 its analysis and recommendations regarding the Utilities’ proposed reliability standards<sup>1</sup>, including proposed modifications to the regulations incorporating such annual standards for the 2016-2019 timeframe. Other parties may file reply comments to Staff’s recommendations by July 15, 2015.
