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NOTICE INITIATING RULEMAKING (RM70) REGARDING SUPPLIER CONSOLIDATED BILLING AND OF VIRTUAL RULEMAKING SESSION

The Maryland Public Service Commission hereby initiates an Administrative Docket, RM70, to consider revisions to the Code of Maryland Regulations ("COMAR") 20.51 (concerning electricity suppliers), 20.53 (competitive electricity supply), and 20.54 (gas suppliers), and 20.59 (competitive gas supply). On September 22, 2020, in Case No. 9461, the Commission's Technical Staff ("Staff") submitted revisions to the aforementioned subtitles to accommodate requirements specific to supplier consolidated billing. Staff also submitted Business Process Flow Documents and Descriptions and Staff's Report Regarding Business Processes behind the revised regulations. On October 9 and 12, 2020, various parties filed comments on Staff's September 22, 2020 filing.

proposed regulations will be published in the Maryland Register for notice and comment as

provided for by the Maryland Administrative Procedures Act.
