SUPPLEMENTAL NOTICE OF VIRTUAL RULEMAKING SESSION (RM 81)

On October 2, 2023, the Commission initiated an Administrative Docket, RM81, to consider revisions to Code of Maryland Regulations ("COMAR") 20.50.¹ The Commission requested comments on the proposed revisions to COMAR 20.50 by Thursday, November 9, 2023, and received a number of comments from various parties.

Accordingly, the Commission hereby gives notice that it will conduct a rulemaking session on Monday, January 8, 2024, at 10:00 AM, via virtual meeting.² The purpose of the rule making session is to consider the proposed regulations filed on September 28, 2023³, by the Leader of the PC44 Interconnection Work Group ("Work Group"), as well as comments received from the parties.
