Proposed Revisions to COMAR 20.50.01 Administrative Docket and 20.50.10 RM83

## Notice Initiating Rulemaking (RM83) and Notice of Rulemaking Session

On April 2, 2024, the leader of the PC44 TOU Rate Design Work Group filed proposed regulations<sup>1</sup> with the Commission as a result of Order No. 90673 and Order No. 91080. The regulations provide clarification to "standard metering practices" for the purpose of allowing time-of-use (TOU) rates and the separate calculation of on- and off-peak consumption and generation. Accordingly, the Commission hereby initiates an Administrative Docket, RM83, to consider the proposed revisions to Code of Maryland Regulations (COMAR) 20.50.01 and 20.50.10

Comments on the proposed regulations shall be e-filed by April 24, 2024.<sup>2</sup> The comments should be addressed to Andrew S.
