Maryland Public Service Commission Schedules Public Hearing for Sol Phoenix Solar Project in Prince George's County

(BALTIMORE, MD-September 14, 2017) – The Maryland Public Service Commission will hold a public comment hearing on the application of Sol Phoenix Solar, LLC to construct a 2.5 MW solar generating facility in Prince George's County, Maryland. The hearing will be held on **Thursday, September 28, 2017** at **6:30pm** at the **Holiday Inn Express and Suites, 9101 Basil Court in Largo, Maryland.** Members of the public who wish to comment on the matter are welcome to attend the hearing before Chief Public Utility Law Judge Terry J. Romine.
