TO: ALL COMMUNICATIONS COMPANIES AS DEFINED IN THE MARYLAND STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE, §3A-501(c), ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND AND MARYLAND STATE DEPARTMENT OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (DoIT)

Re: Universal Service Trust Fund – Revised Surcharge

The State Finance and Procurement Article, §3A-506, Annotated Code of Maryland established a Universal Service Trust Fund to be funded by the collection of a surcharge from subscribers to a communications service¹ and other funds as provided in the State budget. The Fund is used to support the cost of a telephone message relay system for disabled individuals. The statute provides that the Maryland Public Service Commission (“Commission”) shall determine the surcharge annually.

On April 27, 2016, at its weekly Administrative Meeting, the Commission revised the Universal Service Trust Fund surcharge from \$0.11 to \$0.05 per month for each account.
